Born on New Year’s Eve, 1922 Phyllis was festive by nature. She had a social spirit that endeared her to people. When she was old enough to talk, she would tell her mother in Italian “cappello” which means hat, that was the signal that it was time for them to go out.

As a young girl it was her mission to introduce her relatives who came from Italy to live with her and her parents to American culture and city life. She showed them how to make their way to jobs and night schools by subway, trolley and bus. All together under one roof they relied on each other’s strength and abilities. Phyllis understood this reliance from early on as a child when she and her parents and older brother took to the farm fields in New Jersey as share croppers to survive the Depression. The seclusion did not dampen her spirits rather it enhanced her fortitude and sense for adventure.

One day years later, post WWII she went to visit a distant friend of the family. The houses were attached, and she rang the wrong door bell. The house she went to belonged to her future sister-in-law. Here she met her future husband, Joseph Sabatini. Together they became Josie and Phil and remained that until Joe’s death in 2012.

Phyllis enjoyed music, dancing and travel, but these were only second to her passion, her family. Her husband, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren she nurtured throughout; all credit their chance for success to her. Joe would say of Phyllis; “I’m nothing without her”.

Everyone came to Joe and Phyllis’s house for Sunday and holiday dinners. Along with the children came friends and dates and eventually new family members. It wasn’t just the meal although, what a meal! It was the spirit of welcome from the people inside. Phyllis standing a diminutive 4’10” worked two kitchens, one upstairs and one downstairs. She feed many souls and nurtured many spirits never realizing how much she had given because for her there was always the next thing to do or one more place to go.
