College Training Program, a venture inaugurated to provide undergraduate education for selected applicants and commissioned officers for duty in WWII. He graduated as an Ensign in 1944.

Following his war service, he returned to Rutgers University under the GI bill and graduated with a BS in Animal Studies as a member of the Class of 1950.

During high school and throughout college, Mr. Dennery worked part-time for his family's business, Dennery's Dairies in Gloucester City, taking on full-time responsibilities after graduating. When the business was sold in the late 1950's, he and one of his aunts partnered to form DECCO Quick Clean, a chain of coin-operated laundromats, which he owned, operated and maintained until his retirement in the early 1990's.

Edward was inducted in the Gloucester City Lions Club in 1953 and was the oldest and longest serving member. He served as President from 1974-1975 and was a recipient of the Melvin Jones Award. He was also instrumental in the creation and building of the Gloucester City Swim Club.

Predeceased by his wife of 61 years, Joanne Milner Dennery, his parents, Helen C. of Gloucester City and Edward J. Dennery, of California, and his sister Alice Mitchel, of California.
