Steve served as the Gloucester High School Head Coach for eleven years before stepping down following the 1975 season. Coach enjoyed great success during his eleven seasons, compiling a record of 61-35-4. His teams won Tri-County Conference Championships in 1965, 1966, 1969, 1970 and 1971. His 1966, 1969 and 1970 teams won South Jersey Group II titles.

Steve was selected by his peers at the Brooks-Irvin Memorial Football Club Coach of the Year in 1969.

During the 1969, 1970 and 1971 seasons, his teams were undefeated for three years compiling a record of 25-0-2. Coach has also been inducted into the GHS Athletic Hall of Fame, and the Tri-Country Conference Hall of Fame. Steve also served the Athletic Community of South Jersey by acting as a Basketball Official for many years and was a member of the I.A.B.O.

Sister Gertrude Mary earned her BS in Home Economics from the College of St. Elizabeth, her MA in Education from Fordham University, and her MS in Chemistry from the University of Notre Dame, Indiana.

Sister Gertrude Mary began her ministry in secondary education at Mount Saint Mary Academy in Newburgh, NY, in 1935 as a chemistry teacher. She transferred to the biology department where she remained until 1965.
