"Jack always spoke highly of Gloucester City. He would tell perfect strangers what a great place it was to live and grow up. He remembered everything that happened in his hometown in the 1950's. He could tell you all the hangouts, dances, fights. He seemed to be right in the middle of all the fights."

"He had a sharp tongue, a quick wit, and a 'you can count on me attitude. Our family and his friends will miss him so," said Mike.
